



**Drop off and Pick Up** - One parent or guardian must escort their child(ren) to the camp location in the Stockton Art Gallery. The parent/guardian must sign in with the Camp Director at the front desk to verify drop off and pick up. Drop off is between 8:55 – 9:05 am. Pick up is at 12:00 pm.

**Snack Breaks** - Please send campers with a water bottle with their name on it and a nut-free snack. We will not be providing any snacks. Snack breaks will be located outside, weather permitting.

**Hygiene and Cleaning Protocols** - We recommend that upon arrival that all campers wash their hands or use hand sanitizer before joining the class. There will be hand sanitizer available, and bathrooms are across the hallway from the camp location. Staff will encourage campers to take a bathroom break before and after their snack break. Surfaces will be disinfected at the end of each day.

**COVID-19 Policies and Procedure** - The Noyes will communicate and educate staff, parents, and campers in COVID-19 safety measures including:

- Proper hand washing and social distancing
- Wearing face coverings (*See Stockton University Guidelines below*)
- Avoiding touching your face as much as possible
- Staying home when feeling ill or coming into contact with a person infected with COVID-19

**Stockton University COVID-19 Guidelines** - Both campus visitors and camp participants should be aware of Stockton's mask guidelines:
