The High School Internship Program May 18- June 12th 2010

The Noyes Museum of Art offers an internship program that allows high school seniors and juniors with an interest and/or background in art and art history to participate in projects and programs designed to broaden an understanding of the Museum and deepen knowledge of art, meet members of the Museum staff, and work behind the scenes. Interns meet on four (4) weekends throughout the fall, spring, and summer months. An application process is required. *Please note that space in this program is limited.*

The deadline for spring applications is **April 6, 2010**.

Eligibility Requirements for the Spring/Summer 2010 High School Internship Program

1. You must be enrolled as a junior or senior in a high school during the winter/spring 2010.
2. You must have an interest in art and art history.
3. You must have a minimum 2.0 ("C") Grade Point Average.
4. You must be able to commit to four (4) Saturdays in spring 2010.

Application Requirements for the Spring 2010 High School Internship Program

- Completed application form (2 pages)
- Two (2) letters of recommendation [one (1) should be from a teacher or school supervisor]
- One (1) copy of your official high school transcript
- All documents required to complete the application must be submitted in ONE envelope postmarked by **April 5, 2010** and addressed to:
